- DS to discuss with Martin Shields the crossing for the roundabout.
- Initial discussions held with DS & David Medlock (Chair of Foxhill Forum) about the roles of the Stakeholder Forum & Foxhill Forum and how they potentially overlap.
- It was agreed that there is some duplication and that it would be useful to look to setting up a number of work streams to report to the Foxhill
