## Gas safety checks

- The Gas Safe Register advises that you get all your gas appliances checked once a year.
- If you rent your home to anyone, this annual check is a legal requirement.
- ▶ The check must be made by a Gas Safe registered engineer.
- To find a Gas Safe registered engineer visit www.gassaferegister.co.uk
- Make sure they can provide you with a gas safety certificate in the form of a Landlord Gas Safety Record.

## Electrical safety checks

- We ask that you have all the electrics in your property checked every five years.
- If you rent your home to anyone, this five-yearly check is a legal requirement.
- You can find an approved contractor by visiting www.niceic.com
- Make sure they can provide you with an Electrical Installation Condition Report (EICR).
