This booklet tells what to do if there is a fire where you live.

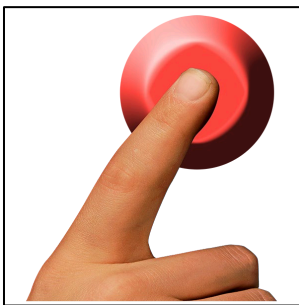
Tell someone if there is a fire



If there is a fire, keep calm and act quickly.



If you have a **pendant alarm**, press the button to call for help.



A **pendant alarm** is a necklace you wear with a button on. When you press the button it will tell someone that there is a problem and you need help.



If help does not come straight away, **call 999** and tell them your exact address.

What to do if there is a fire



Read your nearest **Fire Action Notice** and do what it says. A **Fire Action Notice** is a sign that tells you what to do if there is a fire.



Fire Action Notices are normally on the wall near the front and back exits of your building.



You should find your nearest Fire Action Notice and read it now. If you need anything explained, please tell us.



If a Fire Action Notice is missing or damaged, please tell us.

Fire doors



Some doors are **fire doors**. **Fire doors** slow the spread of fire.



Fire doors should never be left open or damaged.



We check fire doors regularly to make sure they are working and not broken.



If you see a problem with a fire door, please tell us.
